



COMMANDER

Morley Munro, longtime principle of Commander Yachts, has recently sold the company to Mission-based megayacht builder Rayburn Yachts. Munro has retained ownership of Canmar Yachts and will focus on selling new and used Commanders. Rayburn will continue to build the Commander 26 and 30 models, but are also putting the finishing touches on a revived Commander 38, which will be unveiled at the Vancouver boat show in February. The 38 never really got off the ground when it was first made available in the late 1990s because the company found itself at full capacity building its 26 and 30-footers. The 38 is now being brought back as a result of requests by existing Commander owners who wish to upgrade to a larger vessel. The 38 will be built from the original hull and deck molds, but the interior will see a full modernization. Standard power will be twin 370-hp Volvo-Penta diesels with DPH stern drives and potentially Volvo-Penta IPS pod drives.
